



"I Gotta Spend Time With God Every Single Day!"

"I love your sanctuary, Lord, the place where your glorious presence dwells." – Psalm 26:8

READ: Exodus 33

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the leader of the Israelites?
- Who was Moses' assistant?
- What was the name of the place Moses spent time in God's presence?
- After Moses was done meeting with God, what would Joshua do?

SAY:

Joshua is a perfect example of how God prepares us to do His will. Way before he ever led the "Battle of Jericho," Joshua was being prepared for what God was calling him to do.

Moses, Joshua's leader, spent a lot of time with God. He would regularly go to the Tent of Meeting and speak with God face to face. When he would leave the tent, Joshua would stay. Joshua knew he needed to spend time in God's presence.

In today's busy lifestyle, it is easy for us to come up with all kinds of reasons why we can't spend time in God's presence. However, if we want God to use us to do EXTREME things for God tomorrow, we must spend time in His presence today.

DISCUSS:

- Can we gain strength from God to do big things for Him? Explain.

PRAY:

Have a time of worship and reflection—teaching your children how to wait in God's presence. Remind them that "If I want God to use me tomorrow, I must spend time in His presence today."
