FAMILY DEVOTION

I'M IN TROUBLE: "Open Your Eyes"



"Even When I Cannot See, God's Right There To Rescue Me!"

"Then Elisha prayed, 'Lord, open his eyes and let him see.'" – 2 Kings 6:17

SAY:

It is easy to get discouraged by what we see or don't see. We often look in front of us and only see problems, sickness, and defeat. We focus on the problems we DO see and rarely focus on the solution we don't see. When we don't always physically see how God is working on our behalf, we tend to forget He is always there fighting on our behalf.

READ:

2 Kings 6:8-23

DISCUSS:

- Who led an army against Elisha?
- Did the King of Aram fight fair?
- What did Elisha pray for his servant?
- What did the servant see after Elisha prayed?

SAY:

God opened the eyes of Elisha's servant to see what was already there: an army of angels ready to do battle and bring the victory! We can learn from that story how to focus on the God we don't see rather than the TROUBLE they do see. All you have to do is pray for God to "open your eyes" and He will do it. He will help you remember that He is there fighting for you!

PRAY:

Pray for your children who may be struggling with feeling like God is not there. Pray that God will open their eyes to see that He is not only there for them, but He is working to bring the victory for them!
