“...‘Go out...and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full!’” - Luke 14:23

SAY:

God wants as many people as possible to be in relationship with Him. He invites everyone to come to the “table” of salvation and have His blessings and eternal life with Him.

Sadly, so many people don’t accept His invitation. They have excuses and reasons why they just can’t come to the table of His love. They miss out on what God has for them!

Even more sad is the fact that many Christians have all kinds of excuses for why they don’t invite people to God’s table, as well. There are too many empty seats in our churches.

READ:

Luke 14:15-24

DISCUSS:

- Did the original invited guests show up?
- Who did the master tell his servant to go invite?
- Did people finally show up to the banquet?
- Who did the master represent in our story?
- Who did the servant represent in our story?

SAY:

As long as there are people who do not know Jesus, we have to do **WHATEVER** it takes to invite them to God’s house and bring them to “The Table” of God’s love. No excuses! No delay! We must fill the empty seats!

PRAY:

Have your children think of people in their school, neighborhood, and family who need to come to Jesus. Have them pray for God’s help to be bold in inviting them to God’s table.
