SAY:

READ:

2 Chronicles 34

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the kid who became king?
- How old was Josiah when he was crowned king?
- What did Josiah order to be torn down?
- Was Josiah's reign a successful one?
- Should you wait until you are older to do BIG things for God?

SAY:

Josiah became king when he was still a kid. He didn't let his young age keep him from doing what God led him to do. His decisions changed a whole nation and drew the people closer to God.

Through the story of Josiah, we learn that we are never too young to be an example of Jesus for ALL people!

PRAY:

Pray for your children to trust God and believe He will use them in a big way! Pray that they won't allow their young age to be an excuse for not following Jesus and being an example of His love to everyone around them!
