JOSHUA: EXTREME HERO

“You Want Me To Do WHAT?”



“I Will Trust In The Lord My God!”



“Trust in the Lord always, for the Lord God is the eternal Rock.”

– Isaiah 26:4

READ:

Joshua 6

DISCUSS:

- Who was the leader of the Israelite Army?
- What city did God tell Joshua to destroy?
- What did Joshua do when he needed a plan?
- How many times did God want Joshua and the army to march around the wall on the last day?

SAY:

Joshua and the Israelites crossed the Jordan River, but now they faced a large city of Jericho with huge walls around it. On top of that, God gave them some crazy instructions in order to win the victory over Jericho.

To defeat Jericho, they would have to walk around the city once a day for six days without saying a word and then, on the seventh day, walk around the city seven times and yell. That was the plan.

The Israelites had to learn a big lesson in trust. We must trust God's plan, even when it may not make sense!

DISCUSS:

- Can you always trust God to do what is best?

PRAY:

Pray with your kids who may have a hard time trusting God. Maybe it “doesn't make sense” to them that they should “love their enemies” or “give 10% of their money to God” or “turn the other cheek.” Pray that they will learn to trust God just like Joshua did.
