## THE TABLE:

“Humble Yourself And The Lord Will Lift You Up!”



“For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.” - Luke 14:11

## SAY:

We live in a world that says, “Look out for #1!” Commercials tell us to “treat yourself right” and “have it your way!” Everywhere you look online, people are obsessed with “selfies.”

Jesus encourages us to never put ourselves first. Instead, we are to put others first. In fact, we are to put ourselves LAST! After all, that is exactly what Jesus did!

## READ:

Luke 14:7-11

## DISCUSS:

- Where was Jesus in the Bible Story?
- What were all of the guests doing that Jesus had to correct?
- Which seat did Jesus tell everyone to always sit in?
- Does Jesus want us to be full of pride?
- Should we always try to put others ahead of ourselves?

## SAY:

Jesus gave us the greatest example of humility. He **CHOSE** to humble Himself, leave Heaven, and come to Earth as a human. He put the lives of others ahead of His own life.

We learn from the story of Jesus at the banquet that each of us should make a habit of humbling ourselves. It is only then that God can exalt us to where He wants us to be.

## PRAY:

Pray for your children to resist the temptation to “exalt themselves.” Pray that they will choose to be humble. Help them think of ways to serve others this week. Help them put others first and themselves last.
