TEACH US TO PRAY:
“Give God The Praise”



“I Will Praise The Lord For Everything He’s Done!”



“For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen.” - Matthew 6:13b

SAY:

The Lord’s Prayer ends with an amazing line of praise to God. “Praise” is saying nice things about God, thanking Him for what He’s done. We always want to end our prayer with praise to God, thanking Him for what He’s done! As much as all of us love to be thanked and to be praised, God loves it even more! And, He is worthy of SO MUCH more praise than we could ever give Him. That’s why we always want to end our prayer time praising him and thanking Him for who He is and what He’s done!

READ:

1 Samuel 17-24

ASK/DISCUSS:

- Who was running from King Saul?
- Why was King Saul chasing after David?
- Where was David hiding?

SAY:

David was hiding in a cave, but he didn’t let his situation keep him from worshipping God. He still wrote songs of praise to God while in the cave! It is important to give God praise even when things are not necessarily going the way we want them. No matter what, we should give God the praise He deserves. Check out one of the songs David wrote while he was in the cave hiding from King Saul!

READ:

Psalm 34

PRAY:

Have your kids think of all the things that God has done for them. Lead them in a prayer of praise to God. Thank God for His love, power, and blessings! Perhaps end with a song of celebration!
