"God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble..." – Psalm 46:1

SAY:

Storms come in all shapes and sizes. Whether a tornado, thunderstorm, or a hurricane - they are all scary and can cause damage. Life is full of storms, as well. They may not be physical storms, but they are storms that bring trouble and difficulty and can be very scary.

READ:

Genesis 6-7

DISCUSS:

- What did God ask Noah to build? Did Noah obey?
- Why did God ask Noah to build a boat?
- How many of each animal did God send to the ark?
- Did Noah have to catch all the animals?
- How many days and night did it rain?

SAY:

It wasn't easy, but Noah and his family obeyed God in the midst of a horrible storm. When they obeyed, they saw God's amazing power at work. They were saved from the storm. When we follow God and obey His commands (no matter how difficult), we will find miracles taking place in our own lives. God will shelter us in the midst of life's difficult storms.

DISCUSS:

- Are you facing any storms?
- How can God help you through the storms of life you are facing?

PRAY:

Pray that your children would find safety in their Comforter and that God would provide a miracle and shelter them from the storm.
