"Keep watch and pray, so that you will not give in to temptation..."

- Mark 14:38

SAY:

Sometimes we face hard times - even as Christians. It is super important what we do when trouble comes our way! Some people become angry or scared and start to panic. Some people lose control of their emotions and even blame other people or God for their problems.

Followers of Jesus should act different when they face hard times. Jesus taught his disciples how to face their troubles in Mark, chapter 14.

READ:

Mark 14:32-42

DISCUSS:

- Where did Jesus take the disciples after the Last Supper?
- What did Jesus ask the disciples to do?
- Was Jesus excited to be crucified?
- What were the disciples doing when Jesus came back to check on them?
- Whose will did Jesus pray would be done?

SAY:

When we face hard times, we shouldn't let our anger or fear make us lose control. We also shouldn't blame others or God for our problems. Instead, when we face hard times, we should ask God for help and pray for His will to be done!

PRAY:

Pray with your children about any difficulties in their lives right now. Pray that God will help them and that He will allow His will to be done in their lives.
