"Who's Sitting At Your Table?"



"I'll Invite Others To The Table!"



"For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life." - John 3:16

SAY:

It's so easy for Christians to get into the habit of going to church, getting excited about God, and then going back to "real life" and not talking about God the rest of the week.

If we are going to make a difference in this world, we have to share with others what God has done in our lives. God wants to do the same thing in other people's lives that He has done in ours.

READ:

Mark 2:13-17

DISCUSS:

- Who did Jesus ask to be His disciple in the Bible Story?
- What was Matthew's job?
- What kind of people did the religious leaders not want Jesus eating with?
- Who did Jesus say needs a doctor?

SAY:

How will others ever know that God has a seat for them at His table if we never even invite them? It is OUR job to reach out to those around us who do not know Jesus. We must share God's love with them, praying and believing that they will accept His love and forgiveness, just as we have. We need to invite them to join us at "The Table!"

PRAY:

Have your children think of one person they can share their faith with this week. Let them pray for that person and ask God to prepare their hearts. Ask God to help them share their faith with that person this week.
