## JUST DO IT!

“The Two Greatest Commands”



“If I Love God, Then I’ll Love You!”



“...You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind!...Love your neighbor as yourself.” - Matthew 22:37-39

### SAY:

Jesus had a group of people who did not like Him very much - the Pharisees. The Pharisees were constantly trying to come up with riddles, questions, and other tricks to trap Jesus in His own words.

### READ:

Luke 10:30-37

### DISCUSS:

- What happened to the man in today’s Bible Story as he was traveling down the road?
- How many people passed by and didn’t help the man?
- Who stopped to help the man?
- Who paid for the hotel room the man stayed in?
- Did the Levite and the priest show love to the man?

### SAY:

The Pharisees asked Jesus, “What is the greatest commandment?” They hoped to trick Jesus into giving an answer that would make him look foolish in front of the crowd.

Instead, Jesus gave a very simple answer that is the guide for Christians today - “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind... Love your neighbor as yourself.”

### PRAY:

Allow your children to evaluate their own lives. Do they show God how much they love Him by loving other people? Have them pray for God’s help to love others. This shows how much they love God.
