## Tell Me A Story: “The Lost Sheep”



“Jesus Came To Save The Lost!”



“For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.”  
– Luke 19:10

### Say:

Jesus was on a mission! He left Heaven and came to Earth in order to seek and save those who were lost and without a relationship with God.

Often, people who are lost don't realize they are lost. They think they are just living their life and having a great time. All the while, they do not realize that they are wandering in a dark wilderness without a purpose.

### Read:

Luke 15:1-7

### Ask/Discuss:

- How many sheep did the shepherd own?
- What happened to one of his sheep?
- What did the shepherd do when he noticed one of his sheep was missing?
- What did the shepherd do with the other 99 sheep?
- Who did the shepherd in the story represent?

### Say:

Jesus told the Parable of the Lost Sheep in order to illustrate how God feels when one of His children is lost. He will go through whatever it takes to seek out and find that one lost sheep. God will go through great lengths to seek and save His children.

### Pray:

Pray for your children who may need to receive Jesus as their Savior. Then, lead them in a prayer for the family and friends they know who are “lost.” Pray that God will use them to reach their family and friends for Jesus!
