TEACH US TO PRAY:

“I’m Gonna Do My Father’s Will!”



“Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.” - Matthew 6:10

SAY:

Many children have big plans for when they “grow up.” Some dream of being a fireman, policeman, princess, or scientist. As they grow, they pursue those plans wholeheartedly. We all have plans and dreams for our lives, but we must never forget that we are to seek God’s will for our lives, not our own. Sometimes God’s will lines up with our plans, but other times it is completely different. One thing is for sure, God’s plan is always the perfect plan.

READ:

1 Samuel 3

ASK/DISCUSS:

- When God called Samuel’s name, who did Samuel think had called him?
- What did Eli tell Samuel to say to God next time he heard his name called?

SAY:

We need to seek and follow God’s will for our lives. We must do our best to listen for God’s voice, obey His will, and say, “Thy will be done” each and every day of our lives.

ASK/DISCUSS:

- What are some things you have not surrendered to God, allowing His will to be done? How can you change that?

PRAY:

Lead your children in a prayer to have God’s will be done in their lives. Lead them in a prayer of surrendering their own will and being willing to listen and obey God.
