SAY:

Throughout the church’s history, Christians have struggled to work together in unity. People have strong feelings about how we should go about accomplishing God’s work. Many times, those feelings and ideas differ from other Christians.

Too often, Christians begin to fight against each other rather than work together in unity. Nothing causes more damage to the Kingdom of God than when the people of God begin to hurt and destroy each other.

READ:

Exodus 17

DISCUSS:

- What army were the Israelites fighting against?
- Who was the general of the Israelite army?
- What happened every time Moses lowered his arms?
- What did Aaron and Hur do to help Moses?

SAY:

We can learn from the story of Moses, Joshua, Aaron, and Hur what it looks like to work in unity. God wants His people to work together in unity. We won’t always agree, but when we disagree we should do so in love, trying to compromise with one another.

DISCUSS:

- How can you do your part to work together in unity with others?

PRAY:

Pray with your children that God would help all of us to work together to accomplish the BIG task of reaching the world for Jesus.
