“Pay”



“I Will Be Smart And Follow God’s Plan!”



“Follow God’s example in everything you do...” – Ephesians 5:1 (TLB)

SAY:

Money talks - and often it says, “Spend me however you want!” We often think we can just do whatever we want with our money - following any plan we want.

Even worse, some people don’t follow a plan at all. They just spend their money on whatever they feel like. They end up finding themselves either deep in debt or completely broke once they become adults.

READ:

Genesis 4:1-15

DISCUSS:

- What were the names of the brothers in our Bible Story?
- What did Cain bring as an offering to God?
- What did Abel bring as an offering to God?
- Whose offering did God accept?
- How much of our money is “the tithe”?

SAY:

The Bible has some very important things for us to learn when it comes to how we spend our money. We should pay our tithe first, then pay ourselves (saving for emergencies).

Another important lesson has to do with debt. We should not get ourselves deep in debt as we grow older. We avoid this by paying cash for everything - avoiding credit cards as much as possible!

PRAY:

Pray that your children will follow these principles closely! Pray that they will put God first in their tithe, save money for the future, and avoid debt by paying cash for everything!
