Marriage is one of the most special and holy things that God has established. Although you are not going to be considering marriage for a long time, it's important that you begin to understand the importance of marriage.

Marriage is a serious commitment, and husbands and wives must be faithful to one another for a lifetime.

Once a man is married, he is saying, "I will love and honor ONLY my wife for the rest of my life." No girlfriends! Once a woman is married, she is saying, "I will love and honor ONLY my husband for the rest of my life." No boyfriends!
