READ:

Mark 5:22-42

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the man who approached Jesus
- What did Jairus want Jesus to do?
- Did Jesus go to Jairus' home immediately?
- What did Jesus say about the girl - she was not dead but _____?
- What did Jesus tell the little girl to do?

SAY:

We have all wondered: “Why are some people healed and some people aren’t?” Why does an elderly person with cancer get miraculously healed while an eight year old with leukemia dies?

The Bible teaches us that sickness and death entered the world as a result of sin. Living with sickness and disease was never something God wanted for us. However, because of man’s sin, many people suffer and even die from disease.

We don’t always understand why God does things the way He does or why He does them when He does, but we can trust Him to make the right decision. Sometimes He chooses to heal people immediately. Sometimes He chooses to wait a while and then heal them. Even other times, God chooses to wait until they get to Heaven to heal them. He knows much more than we do, and we can trust Him to always do what is right.

PRAY:

Lead your children in a prayer for healing - emotional, physical, and/or spiritual. Pray for others' healing. Pray for peace for your children as they trust God’s timing when it comes to healing in their lives and in the lives of others who need healing.
