SAY:

Admitting you were wrong and that you need forgiveness can be a hard thing for some people to do. However, we must admit we have done wrong and ask for forgiveness from God.

We can learn from a man who was being crucified on a cross next to Jesus all about the importance of asking for forgiveness of our sins.

READ:

Luke 23:32-43

DISCUSS:

- How many thieves were crucified with Jesus?
- Were both thieves believers in Jesus?
- What did the thief ask Jesus to do when He entered His Kingdom?
- Did Jesus forgive the thief?

SAY:

As we learn from the story of the thief on the cross, we can see that no matter how much we have done wrong, God is always ready and willing to forgive us. We just need to admit our mistakes and ask for His forgiveness. God loves us and is always ready to forgive.

DISCUSS:

- Have you ever done something wrong and felt bad about it?
- Why do you think it is important to admit our mistakes?
- How do you think God feels when we ask Him for forgiveness?

PRAY:

Pray for your children who need to receive God's forgiveness. Pray for friends and family that need to receive God's forgiveness.
