- 1) Be open before the Lord v.2 (James 1:2-4)
- 2) Remember God's acceptance of you v.3
- 3) Refuse to spend time with the wrong people v. 4-5
- 4) Maintain a positive attitude of thanksgiving v. 6-7
- 5) Be faithful in public worship v.6-8 (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- 6) Patiently stand and wait for relief v.11-12 (I Peter 2:18-23)

To Sum It Up

- 2. The mature believer seeks to model the life of Christ.
- 3. The mature believer sees benefit in the trial, not just the pain.
