Discussion Guide

- Take a moment and share your highs and lows of your day.
- What makes a day a “good day” for you? What makes a day a “bad day?”
- How would you describe Jesus’ transfiguration to someone with little to no knowledge of the Bible?
- How would you have responded if you had been on the mountain that day?
- What would you ask Moses and Elijah had you met them on the mountain?
- How often does the thought of “then” (heaven) affect your “now” (time on earth)?
- **Read** Romans 8:18. What might Paul be referring to in his own life? How does his thinking as revealed in Rom. 8:18 help him through the difficulties he faced.
- How might thinking more about the glories of heaven affect how you walk through difficulties here on earth?
- Share with the group how you plan to make Jesus a greater glory this week.
- **PRAY** for Jesus to help any pockets of unbelief in your heart.
- **PRAY** for time spent with Jesus this week that is so good, you radiate his glory for others to see.

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
