- Which of the activities of the church in Acts 2 seem challenging?
- "If the pastors and staff were to disappear tomorrow, would we 'have church' on Sunday?" How would you answer? What would need to happen to be able to answer 'Yes?'
- Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What does this passage say about the importance of God's Word? What is it to be used for?

#### **Live Out**

- What would it take for our church or our small group to look like the fully devoted community described in Acts 2? What would need to change?
- What practical things need to change in your life in order to be a part of a fully devoted church?
- Who do you know that might respond to the gospel if they saw the invisible God through the visible effects of the church?
- Go around the room and answer what the group can do to become more fully devoted to each other.

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
