The Approach

"Lord, if you will, you can make me clean."

The Touch

"And Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him,"

The Word

"I will: be clean."

The Result

"And immediately the leprosy left him."

Worship Jesus even before he works on your problem.

Bring it to Jesus with bold humility.

Trust the care and power of the Savior.

GROUP / FAMILY DISCUSSION

- Do you know of anyone (or have you personally) wrestled with the idea that Jesus neither can nor will heal you or fix your situation?
- Why do you think you or others have felt this way?
- Why is it significant that three Gospel writers share the story in almost the same way?
- Describe how you might feel if you were a leper in ancient Israel?
- According to 1 John 1:7, what does Jesus cleanse us from today?
- Who would you say are the "untouchables" around you today?
- How can you begin to make contact with them for the glory of God?
- Is there something you need to bring to Jesus for him to take care of?
- How can we walk with you this week as God heals you?
- How might God be using the healing in your life to witness to those in your family, at work, etc.?
- Pray for this person and how God might use you to reach them.

Various Scriptures

Matthew 4:17

17 From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Romans 1:16-17

- What can you do practically this week to move up one step on the scale?
- If someone were to ask on what do you base your salvation, how would you answer?
- Who do you know (family, friend, coworker) that needs a reformation of the heart through faith in Jesus?
- Pray for this person and how God might use you to reach them.
