**Philippians 1:12-21**

### **Make Jesus the center.**

*Jesus has not come to make you **happy** but to make you **holy**.*

*What is at the center of your life?*

### **See the gospel work in your present circumstances.**

*Paul views his situation in light of the gospel.*

*Paul views EVERY situation in light of the gospel.*

### **Expect the gospel to work in all circumstances.**

*Your goal in life:*

**Faithfulness.** Faithfulness **to** the God who called you and faithfulness **in** the places He's called you to.

*Watch for opportunities to share and live out the gospel.*

## GROUP / FAMILY DISCUSSION

- Knowing Paul's situation as a prisoner, describe how you might be feeling and what your attitude might be like concerning what might be next?
- "We have a problem today of secular Christians." What was meant by that term? Do you agree?
- What might it look like for someone to have Jesus as a part of their life but not the center?
- What does it look like for someone to have Jesus at the center of their life?
- Can you share a way you have seen the gospel at work in your present circumstance?
- Are there situations in your life in which you are struggling to see how God could use for the gospel and His glory?
- Read **Luke 9:23-24**. Describe what it might be like to "take up a cross." What feelings emotions would you feel? What does it mean to deny yourself? How is this different from what some might expect from Christianity?
- What does your life look like when you forget that "the King currently rules?"
- Why is this important?
- **Repent** of anything that is taking Jesus' place at the center of your life. **Pray** for faithfulness to expect the gospel to work in and through you in 2022. **Pray** for someone you'd like to see trust in Christ this year.

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
