
Genesis 2:8-9

There are Two aspects of life (kingdom) for today: visible and invisible life. We tend to see it as two kingdoms, two realms, two dimensions. But we must see it as one life, not two.

You and I have this invisible life with God that is to be infused into our visible life because when we enter his kingdom, his kingdom enters us. We receive the nature of the king.

We want our visible life to flow out of our invisible, hidden life so that there is a unity, an integrity in all that we do. We will have integrated lives, wholeness in our lives. The Father wants His life to flow in us and to affect every part of our life. He is for us!

His Spirit in us is to surge abundant life through our roots and trunk and branches and leaves and blossoms and fruit. Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth and subdue it, rule over every living thing.

Where does this rulership show up? In the list of things you wrote down. That is where He desires to show up. In your observable life.

When you and I cultivate the nature of the King in our hearts and then step into the world around us, we begin to recognize that His kingdom is already there, present, at hand, in your midst, seekable, seeable, and enterable now.

All of Life backs us up when we perceive the hidden workings and outer workings are one Life. His kingdom is in us, around us. A wholeness, a fullness comes to us.
