APPLYING TRUTH: ACTS 9:10-19

Q1. In verse 13-14, Ananias questions God's choice of Saul, based on past deeds.

- » What reputation do you think the American church has by the unchurched with regard to their past?
- » Do you think the unchurched feels welcome or unwelcome in the American church?
- » How can we do a better job of welcoming all people into the family of God?

Q2. In verse 17, Ananias calls Saul, "brother."

- » Based on the questioning of God in verse 13-14, what does this indicate about the change that occurred in Ananias' heart?
- » What is it that God would have you learn from Ananias' example?
- » Ask God to reveal your willingness to follow His commands, even when you do not like or understand what He is doing.
