APPLYING TRUTH: ACTS 8:4-25

Q1. Verse 7 says, "For unclean spirits, crying out with a loud voice, came out of many who had them, and many who were paralyzed or lame were healed. So, there was much joy in that city."

- » Is this kind of power available to the church?
 - If no, what is the reason it happened then, but not now?
 - If yes, are we seeing these kinds of great signs from God?
 Have you experienced this kind of display of power?
- » If these kinds of displays of power were happening, would we give credit to God or explain it away?
- » If these kinds of displays of power are happening, does it motivate you to tell others about it?
- » Why was there so much joy in that city? Does our city need this same kind of joy?
- **Q2.** Verse 12, tells us that "they believed Philip as he preached good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ." Our culture has taught us to invite people to church, or tell them about a program.
- » Is Phillip's method and message something we need to mimic (He is not a leader or a pastor)?
- » Are we trained to speak the wrong message?
- » Do we need to be retrained?
