APPLYING TRUTH: ACTS 12:6-19

Q1. In section I. God's Unfettered Answer to Prison verses 6-11, we see the Apostle Peter respond to the messenger that God sent to free him from his bondage. He didn't doubt, he didn't try and figure it out, he simply obeyed.

- » Do you remember a time when God called you to action, but all the things that seemed like obstacles kept you from obeying?
- » Do you know of a time when you responded in faith, even though all the obstacles were in sight, but obedience allowed you to trust, faith, and obey?
- » What are the differences to these two responses?
- » Why do the obstacles before us speak so much louder than the God who is able to move mountains?

Q2. In section II. God's Unexpected Answer to Prayer verses 12-17, we see that though the church was praying, God's answer was not what they were expecting.

- » How does your prayer life reflect your belief in God and what He is able and willing to do in response to our prayers?
- » It is encouraging that even in their lack of faith, or their small amount of faith, that God still moved in a mighty way. How might God want this response to serve to encourage you to press into your relationship with Him through prayer?
