APPLYING TRUTH: ACTS 9:1-9

Q1. *In verse 5, it is said that Saul is working against the plan of righteousness that God had for him. God had a plan and was trying to move Saul to the place of peace with God, and Saul fought against Him.*

- » *Have you ever experienced a time when you thought you were doing God's will, later to find out you were working against God?*
- » *How do we grow in the practice of it submitting to the will of the One who really is in control?*
- » *What things can keep you from hearing from and submitting to the will of God?*

Q2. *In verse 9, God tells us that Saul sat quietly, without food and water for three days, waiting on the Lord. Saul had been confronted with the fact that not only was he not serving God, but was fighting against Him.*

- » *When is the last time hearing from God was more important than food, water, or anything you had planned for the day?*
- » *How important is it for us to follow a similar discipline of sitting before the Lord, even without food or water, waiting to encounter God?*
- » *How might people's lives be changed if they regularly sat with the Lord, just listening to His leading?*
