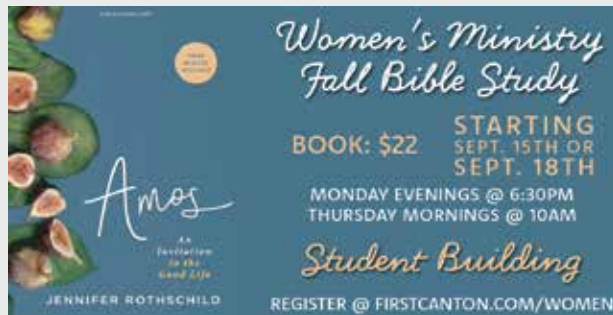
The cost of the book is \$12. We will meet each Tuesday afternoon to study God's word as we work our way through **Max Lucado's book Help Is Here.**
