Hebrews: The Incomparable Christ



The book of Hebrews offers encouragement to sinners [like us] in at least three ways:

1. Access to God - unrestricted
2. Atonement for sin - full and final
3. Assurance of salvation - based upon the finished work of Christ



Hebrews 10 [NIV]

v. 1-18 = doctrine

- The Gravity of Our Sin
- The Inadequacy of Mere Religion
- The Provision of Atonement through Christ



Hebrews 10 [NIV]

v. 19-39 = exhortation

- Sincere Devotion
- Unswerving Hope
- Healthy Caution
- Loving Community



Hebrews 10:22-25 [NIV]

1. Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart [v. 22]
2. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess [v. 23]



Hebrews 10:22-25 [NIV]

3. Let us consider how we may spur one another on to love and good deeds [v. 24]
4. Let us not give up meeting together [v. 25a]
5. Let us encourage one another [v. 25b]
