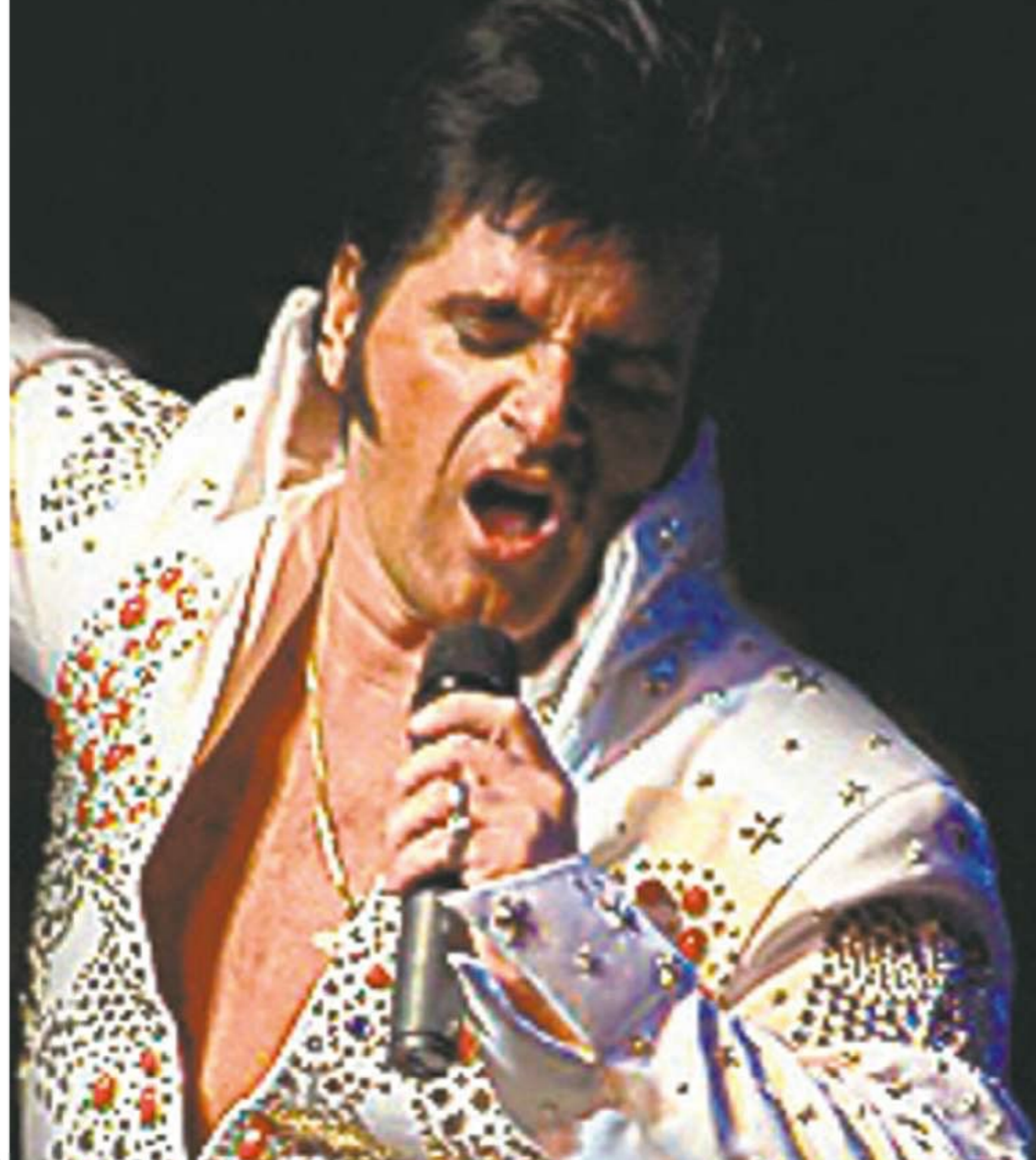

a man.”

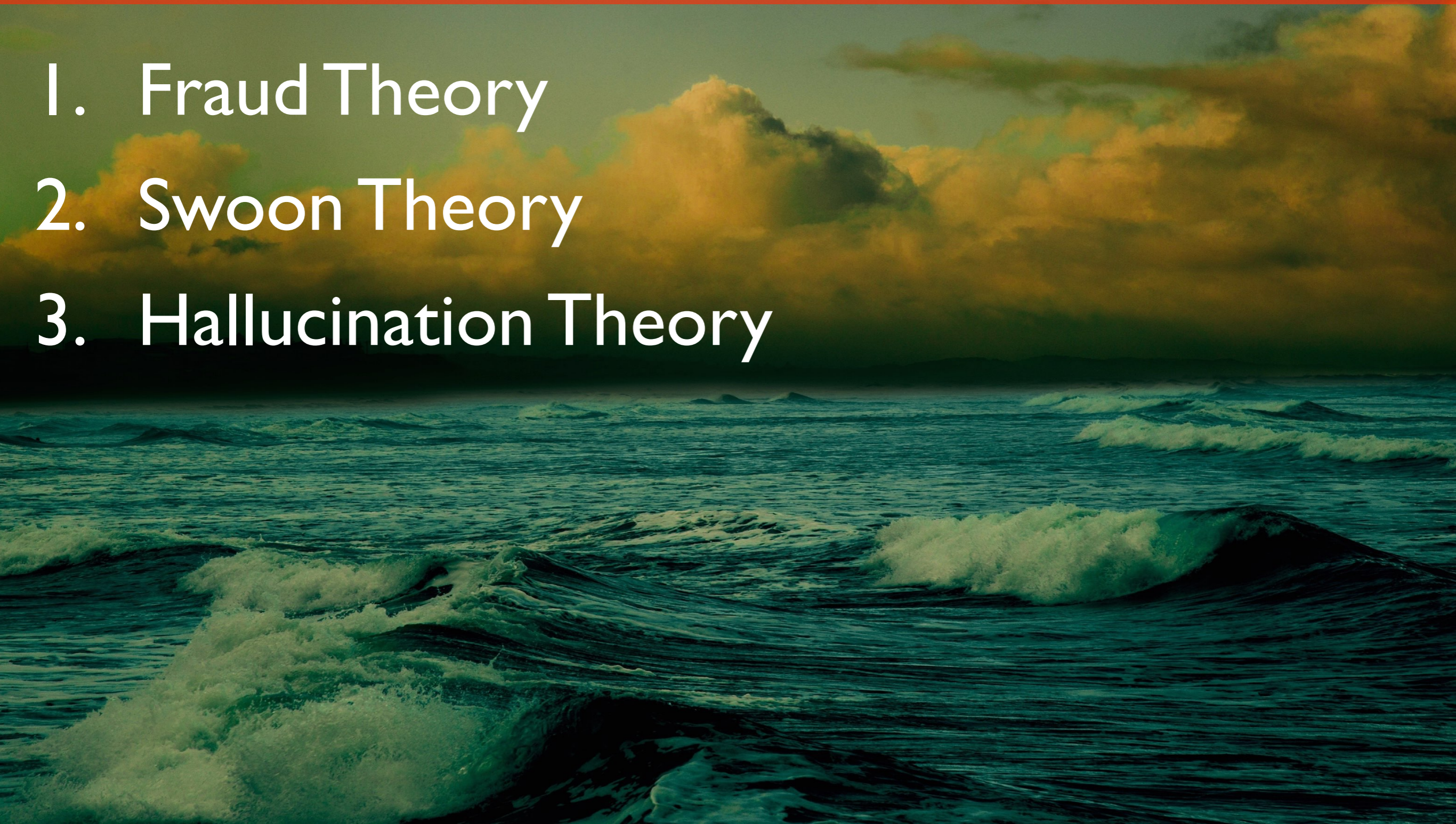
