Sermon Discussion Questions
The Bible Doesn't Say That 2
Part 1: "Being good is good enough."

1. Why does "be good" theology make us feel good? Why do you think so many people think this is the central message of the Bible?
2. Read Luke 18:9-14. What stands out to you as the difference in how each man approaches God?
3. Why do we compare ourselves to others to justify our "goodness"?
4. If God sets the standard, why can't He just ignore sin or grade on a curve?
5. Can you think of some Bible passages that speak to the fact that we as humans are not that good?
6. Read Titus 3:4-7. What is the good news we find in this passage? Why is salvation impossible for humanity but possible with God? (Matt. 18:26-27) How is the gospel message different from every other religion in the world?
