- 4. If God sets the standard, why can't He just ignore sin or grade on a curve?
- 5. Can you think of some Bible passages that speak to the fact that we as humans are not that good?
- 6. Read Titus 3:4-7. What is the good news we find in this passage? Why is salvation impossible for humanity but possible with God? (Matt. 18:26-27) How is the gospel message different from every other religion in the world?
