The Bible Doesn't Say That 2
Part 3: "Everything is possible for those who believe."

**Conversation Starter:** Which superpower would you rather have: be the world's fastest runner or the world's strongest person?

- 1. What is the Biblical context of the statement in Mark 9:23? Or, in other words, what is happening in the story? (Mark 9:14-29)
- 2. What do you think the father meant in vs. 24, "I do believe, help my unbelief"? How does turning toward Jesus with questions and doubts demonstrate at least some faith rather than no faith at all?
- 3. What changes in our understanding of Mark 9:23 when we look at what Paul said in 2 Corinthians 12:9-10?
- 4. Are there examples in your life where you faced "the impossible" and that drove you back to Jesus?
- 5. What can you take away from this message to apply to your own life or share with others?
