Sermon Discussion Questions The Bible Doesn't Say That Part 3: "Follow Your Heart"

1. What sounds right about the suggestion to "follow your heart"? Where have you heard this in American culture? How does this suggestion conflict with this Proverb 3:5?
2. Why isn't the heart a trustworthy moral compass? Why shouldn't we follow the heart? What does Jeremiah 17:9, Romans 1:24, and Matthew 15:19 reveal about the heart?
3. Instead, Pastor Glenn suggests our hearts need to be led. What does that mean? What does John 14:1 reveal?
4. How can we receive a transformed heart and mind? Read Ezekiel 35:26, Romans 12:2

Application:

5. Can you think of a time when you wish you had not followed your heart? Or a time when you look back with thanksgiving that you didn't? Share about those experiences.
6. What part can you play in seeking out a transformed and renewed heart?

Prayer: We don't follow our hearts, we follow Jesus! And right now you are probably aware of some area of your life where Jesus is calling and your heart is stalling. Share with your group an area of your life where you are struggling to get your heart to go where obedience would take you.
