

Sermon Discussion Questions Who is Jesus? The 7 I AM Statements of Jesus Part 6: The True Vine

Opening Discussion/Ice Breaker: Have you ever been chosen for a special task, in school, at work, on a sports team, or in some other setting? How did it make you feel to be asked to play a unique role, or be chosen for a particular team?

Read John 15:1-17

- 1. What struck you the most in this passage?
- 2. What is this fruit that Jesus references? (Read Philippians 1:9-11 & Gal 5:22-23a)
- 3. The image of "Vine" is full of implications we couldn't impact completely during the message. Take a couple of minutes to think through each aspect of Jesus' analogy and how it relates to actual life. What does it mean:

To be a branch of the vine?

To remain in him?

To be cut off? Lifted Up?

To wither and be burned?

To be pruned? To produce fruit/ much fruit?

To be cleansed by the message? To bring glory to the Father?

Application

- 4. Describe a time when we as a church or you as an individual went through a session of pruning. How did your pruning equip you or the church to bear greater fruit?
- 5. How do you feel knowing that Jesus "chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last"? (Vs. 16)

6. Take an extra Step : How can we ensure we are living our lives dependent upon the Spirit of Jesus and not on our own strength?
7. How can we pray for you?
