

Sermon Discussion Questions Kingdom Parables Part 4: The Parable of the Persistent Widow

Read Luke 18:1-8

- 1. Who was Jesus speaking to when He gave this parable? Why is that important?
- 2. In your own words, how would you describe the woman in Jesus story? How would you describe the judge?
- 3. The widow's persistence in the story is described in the original language almost as nagging or "hammering away" at the judge. Do you think this is a positive or negative trait? Why does this motivate the judge to act?
- 4. How is the judge like and dislike God? Why would Jesus use this example?
- 5. Why does Jesus end the story in vs. 8 with a questions about faith? Why do you think "prayer is the chief exercise of faith"?

Application:

- 6. Have you ever been in the position of the widow? In a situation where you felt hopeless, helpless, and weak to improve your situation.
- 7. Why is it important for you to keep praying even when it seems there is no immediate answer?
- 8. How will you pray and not give up? What steps will you take to keep praying? How can you as a growth group to support and encourage one another in prayer?

Prayer: Pray for justice. Pray for a deeper relationship with the Lord in prayer.
