Part 5: The Parable of the Pharisee and Tax Collector

Read Luke 18:9-14

- 1. Who did Jesus target this parable's teaching towards?
- 2. What do you think motivated the Pharisee to pray?
- 3. How would have the Pharisee been perceived when he shared that he fasted twice a week? Why is that important? Why did the Pharisee stand by himself to pray?
- 4. What was the difference between the Pharisee's response to God in prayer and the Tax Collectors? Why do you think the Tax collector stood at a distance?
- 5. What does it mean that one man was justified and the other wasn't? What's the principle here?

Application:

- 6. Is it okay to be better than others? What does this parable teach us about our prayer habits?
- 7. What specific steps can you take this week to cultivate a spirit of humility?
- 8. In what area of your life do you want to combat a tendency to exalt yourself instead of Christ?

Prayer: Pray for humility. Pray for continual growth to see the world through gospel colored lenses.
