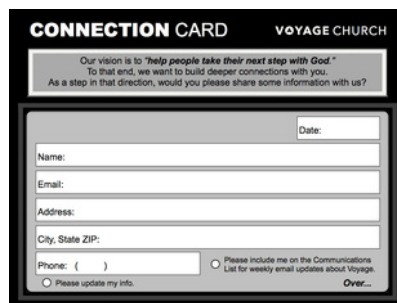

Guest Speaker Today: Mark Bonham



Mark founded Shepherd's Heart in 2011 and served as managing director until 2022. Prior to that Mark was the executive director of Open Hearts Ministry (OHM) for 10 years. He and Mary served for 25 years with the Navigators as campus minister at Hope, Grand Valley and WMU, overseas as the Navigator country leader for Hungary and Romania, and in the Navigator community ministry on the Detroit Metro Mission's leadership team. He has served as chairman of the board for Habitat for Humanity Hungary, and served as the first American representative on the Budapest Chamber of Commerce and Industry in 100 years. Mark has a degree in Business Management, a graduate degree in Bilingual Bicultural Education, and is ordained minister.

He has published articles in Christianity Today's Small Group Resources magazine, authored the Loving Well course for couples, and will soon release his autobiography entitled, "Venturing Behind the Curtain."

Mark serves Voyage as our Growth Group Coordinator. His ministry experience has given him a passion for experiencing life-giving community in safe groups. He and Mary continue to train leaders with Shepherd's Heart in the U.S. and Latin America. Mark and Mary, have two children and seven grandchildren.
