

THE AMAZING POWER OF WORDS

Do we need to learn a new language?

"...that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak..." (Ephesians 6:20)

"...I believed and therefore have I spoken . . . " (II Corinthians 4:13)

See also II Corinthians 4:8-18)

Perhaps we need to discipline ourselves to learn and speak the language of faith, believing in the trustworthiness of God to complete the work He has begun in us.

Words are containers – either of fear or of faith.

"...Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth..." (Proverbs 6:2)

*"Let the words of my mouth, and the meditations of my heart
be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord..." (Psalms 19:14)*

*"I will say of the Lord . . . He is my refuge and my fortress, my God;
in Him will I trust." (Psalm 91:2)*

“And God said, Let there be . . . and there was . . .” (Genesis 1)

Spoken word affected matter. God spoke before action. Words!

“Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear” (Hebrews 11:3).

“Take with you words, and turn to the Lord...” (Hosea 14:2)

Facts about the Voyager spacecraft:

- Launched in 1977
- Travelling at the speed of 38,000 mph for 42 years
- Is now billions of miles into space, leaving our solar system and going into interstellar space. And this expanse of space – and all it contains – was spoken into existence!

Words are powerful!

“...thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.” (Psalm 138:2)

“Forever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven.” (Psalm 119:89)

- All of 119 Psalm

“Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.” (Luke 21:33)

Luke 17:6 – The sycamine tree

Mark 11:23 – The mountain

He spoke words – told us to say words. He spoke end results not present circumstances.

Romans 4:17 – “...*calleth things that be not as though they were...*”

Abraham called name in faith for 25 years – “*who against hope believed in hope...*”

Romans 4:18 – “*According to that which was spoken...*”



Words carry substance – from invisible substance physical world created.

“*Faith is the substance...*” Hebrews 11:1

“*...worlds were framed by the word of God...*” Hebrews 11:3

Angel came for Daniel’s words – Daniel 10:12 – “*...and I am come for thy words.*”

Hosea 14:2 – “*Take with you words, and turn to the Lord...*”

 Oh, be careful little mouth what you say ... 

Words are powerful!

Colossians 4:6 – “*Let your speech be always with grace.*”

Learn a new language. Faith’s language would be a good one!

Words from our tongue direct our life. (Read James 3:1-10)

“The word of God conceived in the heart,
formed by the tongue, and spoken out of the mouth
is creative power.”

“*Where the word of the King is – there is power.*” (Ecclesiastes 8:4).

Seed words/sowing/reaping

Difference in having what you say – and saying what you have.

Words are containers – they carry faith or fear and produce after their own kind.

Job 3:25 – “*What I feared came upon me.*”

Proverbs 6:2 – “*thou art snared with the words of thy mouth*”

Proverbs 18:21 – “*Death and life are in the power of the tongue...*”(that’s words)!
