




Every good husband has to be at least three things:

Likewise, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel, since they are heirs with you of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered. (1 Peter 3:7)

It Takes a Good Husband



Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.

For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband. (Ephesians. 5:25-33)



III. A good husband is a leader.

Responsibility requires Authority

- 1. Husbands are to love their wives sacrificially... benefiting them with righteous actions regardless of reciprocation (v. 25).
- 2. They are to care for their wives as their own bodies (v. 28).
- 3. They are to live with them in an understanding way, providing for their well-being, spiritually and physically (vv. 27 and 29).

Responsibility requires Authority

- 4. This is a great responsibility like Christ and His Church. (vv. 29-30)
- 5. A man sets the example by leaving all other relationships behind and dedicating his life, after Christ to his wife in marriage. (v. 31)
- 6. And a man is to love his wife---and the wife is to see to it that she respects her husband. (v. 33)

It Takes a Good Husband





I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.
