Message Summary

We continue delving into the book of Ephesians, focusing on the call to imitate God's love and live out the gospel in our daily interactions. Questions

2. What practical ways can we "walk in the way of love" in our communities?
3. How can we remind ourselves of Christ's love's vastness when facing challenges?
4. What does it mean to you to be God's masterpiece, and how does that shape your self-worth?
5. How can we guard against the temptations of sexual immorality, impurity, and greed in our own lives?
6. In what ways can we be holy and set apart in a culture that often celebrates sin?

7. How can we balance the call to be countercultural with the need to show love and grace to others?
8. What are some idols in our culture today, and how can we ensure God remains our ultimate priority?

It could be as simple as offering a listening ear to someone in need, volunteering your time, or being intentional about speaking words of encouragement.
