

"God's Design for Marriage: Leading with Love"

Message Summary

In this message, Bruce discusses the biblical perspective on marriage outlined in Ephesians chapter five. He emphasizes the importance of following God's design for marriage, where both husband and wife recognize and submit to one another. The husband takes on the role of a servant leader. Bruce acknowledges the potential controversy surrounding the passage but insists on the necessity of discussing and adhering to these teachings. He highlights that the husband's leadership should be characterized by sacrificial love, mirroring Christ's love for the church. He also emphasizes that wives are called to submit to their husbands as to Christ, not out of coercion, but willingly and in alignment with God's word.

8. How can our church community support and encourage marriages to reflect God's design?
