Taking Jesus Seriously – Part 11: (John 21)

Subtitle: Follow Me

Taking Jesus Seriously: challenges us to recognize His claims, teachings, and authority as central to life—to consider Jesus as the risen Son of God, the way to salvation, and the source of a transformed life.

If I had to say it in one phrase:

To take seriously what the Word of God says about who Jesus is.

Sometimes the problem isn't the *who*. Sometimes the problem is the *how*: How do we hold on to something greater?

Matthew 26:31

'Then Jesus told them, "This very night you will all fall away on account of me, for it is written: I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.

Being a disciple doesn't just mean talking like Jesus, but embodying what Jesus said and did.

We don't always learn things only from what is said, but also from what we witness.

A fan of Jesus, someone who passively admires His message and enjoys the benefits from a distance.

A *follower* of Jesus actively engages with His teachings, commits to obeying His commands, and dedicates their life to Him.

Luke 11:28: Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it.

Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.

We need Jesus by our side.

And by that, I mean taking His teachings, His way of doing things, and learning from His devotion seriously.
