

Unshakable Kingdom - Part 2...NOTES

What does unshakable Kingdom mean?

Hebrews. 12:28 “Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful. By it, we may serve God acceptably, with reverence and awe”

Daniel 2:44a NIV “ The God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed...,this kingdom will endure forever.

If you belong to Christ, you are part of that kingdom.

Heb. 12:28b “Let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe.”

Christ's kingdom is better than any other kingdom we could align our lives with.

Rom. 8:38-39 Nothing can separate you from the love of God in Christ.

Knowing that we have received an unshakable Kingdom, how should this impact our lives today?

Whenever you come to God through faith in Jesus Christ, you receive mercy, forgiveness, and grace

Ephesians 1:17

Is your foundation built on God's unshakable kingdom or is it based on yourself or a worldly allegiance?

If you're here and you do know Jesus as Lord and Savior then there are several things that you must do as obedient followers of Christ. Heb. 12:28

1 Cor. 15:58 encourages us to be steadfast, immovable in light of this reality. Heb. 13:14

The Kingdom of God comes from God; but we have to be active participants in occupying it or advancing it.

You and I are not saved to sit - we are saved to serve.

We need to stop investing our lives in things that can be shaken and to anchor ourselves in the kingdom that cannot. ***“Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us,”***

Hebrews 12:1 NIV

Hebrews 12:25-27, 29 NAS “See to it that you do not refuse Him who is speaking. For if those did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape who turn away from Him who warns us from heaven.

And His voice shook the earth then, but now He has promised, saying, “Yet once more I will shake not only the earth, but also the heaven.”

This expression, “Yet once more,” denotes the removing of those things which can be shaken, as of created things, so that those things which cannot be shaken may remain...for our God is a consuming fire.”
