Let's return to a God-first lifestyle, letting his Word transform our thinking, and our lives, in such a way that it impacts others for God's Kingdom.

Heb. 12:28 NIV

Unshakable means possessing a faith based on God and His Word, which allows us to remain firm and not moved when life gets messy

Joseph spent his life staying faithful to God and the Word he had received.

The secret to Joseph's success was his walk with God.

Joseph was so full of God's presence that when life squeezed him, evidence of his dedication to God oozed out.

Biblical meaning of the word "impact" is defined as the lasting, transformative influence of God's Word in our lives.

Hebrews 4:12 NLT "For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires."

The impact comes because the Word of God has the power to change us

Isa. 40:8 NLT

John 8: 31-32 NLT “Jesus said to the people who believed in him, “You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

The truth will set you free means that understanding, believing, and remaining in Jesus’ teachings delivers people from spiritual bondage

UNBELIEF

Hebrews 3:12, 19

This refusal stems from a heart reluctant to surrender, hindering spiritual growth and the reception of God’s promises.
