

Unshakable Identity - part 2

UNSHAKABLE - state of complete stability, safety and fixed trust that cannot be moved, knocked down or destroyed by outside forces and hard times.

What God has done for us in Christ and who we are as His children.

1 John 3:1-2 NIV “See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! ...

Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.”

“ As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God”

Where do you find yourself seeking identity outside of Christ? Do you find yourself holding tightly to something in fear that you'll be lost without it?

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV), “If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”

It is not what we do that determines who we are; Who we are determines what we do.

Rom. 8:14-15 NIV “For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather,

the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “Abba, Father.””

Your identity in Christ matters because it anchors your self-worth in God’s unchanging grace rather than fleeting emotions, human approval or personal failures

False identities creep in over time, leading us to feel empty or insecure when these worldly markers of value shift or disappear.

Have you ever had an event throw you over the deep end?

To endure hard times your identity has to be rooted in something stronger than yourself.

Colossians 3:2–3 says, “Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.”

When we live a false identity, we build our lives on a foundation that’s guaranteed to crumble.

“He predestined us to be adopted as sons through Jesus Christ for himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace that he lavished on us in the Beloved One,”
