Motivation (Why You Need to Know It):

What is a resolution? It's a <u>decision</u> and <u>determination</u> to do or not do something.

Resolutions are birthed from knowing that I'm not where or who I should be.

- I'm not satisfied with how I act/react (I'm not who I portray)
- I'm not satisfied with how I think (I'm too up or down on myself)
- I'm not satisfied with how I speak (I don't think before speaking)
- I'm not satisfied with how I progress (I'm staying the same or moving backward)

Three Steps to a Resolution -

- A Decision to Change (this is not enough by itself)
- A Plan to Progress (where the real work happens)
 - Commitment to the Truth
 - Measure the Outcome
 - Choose Accountability (God's Word and others who care about you)
- A Commitment to Endure (Some quit at the first sign of failure)

Most never move past the first step because they don't prepare for the next two steps.

Information (What You Need to Know):

Scripture is full of resolutions.

James wrote about faith resolutions that every Christ follower should have as a part of their daily life.

Who was James?

- Oldest half-brother of Jesus
- Rejected Jesus as Savior but later believed
 John 7:5 (ESV) For not even his brothers believed in him.
- Co-laborer with Apostles/Leader in Jerusalem Church
- Martyred for his faith (AD 62)

Why was James writing?

- Challenge to persecuted Jewish Christians to be faithful (Acts 12)

 James 1:1 (NLT) This letter is from James, a slave of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ. I am writing to the "twelve tribes"—Jewish believers scattered abroad. Greetings!
- Combat worldliness and fighting in the church (James 1:27; 4:4)
- Encourage to live out one's faith, be a doer and not just a hearer

We'll be talking about the *13 Faith Resolutions in the book of James*. First Faith Resolution – I Will Endure Trials.

Three Steps to a Resolution:

Decision to Change - Trials are to be embraced, not escaped

- An Opportunity for Joy
 - James 1:2 (NLT) Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy.
- An Opportunity for Endurance
 - James 1:3 (NLT) For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.
- An Opportunity for Maturity
 - **James 1:4 (NLT)** So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.

An untested faith is a weak faith.

Plan to Progress – Ask for God's wisdom during trial

Wisdom – God-given perspective in practical matters

Seek God's Wisdom First

James 1:5 (NLT) If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking.

Seek God's Wisdom in Faith

James 1:6 (NLT) But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. 7 Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. 8 Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do.

A Commitment to Endure – Remain patient during trial

James 1:12 (NLT) God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

- God Blesses those who Endure (inherits maturity and confidence in God)
- God Rewards those who Endure (inherits eternal life)
