The Supremacy of Jesus Christ Worthy of All Praise Hebrews 13:15

Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet,

and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to

our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

This is a day of celebrating The Lord our God and all He has done for us, don't mourn over all your failures, focus on the One always worthy of praise and celebrate! Nehemiah's exhortation to the nation of Israel is just as fitting for us today and every day...

Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is,

the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name. But do not forget to do good

and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. Hebrews 13:15-16 NKJV

<u>Sacrifice of praise</u> – pride, fear and apathy must die <u>Fruit of our lips</u> – from out of the heart the mouth speaks (confesses) Law of God, the fear of God and The Holy Spirit are in the believer's heart Praise is a natural fruit of all who are filled with the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 5:18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, 20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,
21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." 6 So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

III. JESUS CHRIST THE IMMUTABLE ONE

Hebrews 13:7 Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of *their* conduct. **8** Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever. **9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For *it is* good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them. **10** We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. **11** For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. **12** Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. **13** Therefore let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. **14** For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come.

<u>Remember</u> the example of those who led you (v.17 present leaders – leaders of congregations not individuals – leaders are not autocratic chiefs lording it over a church family – they are to be servants of JESUS CHRIST as HE exercises HIS Ministry

of apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, teacher through them to the maturing of all – Ephesians 4:1-16)

<u>JESUS – JESUS – JESUS</u> – ever the same! <u>GRACE</u> – NOT WORKS OR BY THE LAW! (Doctrines = false doctrines) <u>Stay focused</u> on JESUS CHRIST, The Author & The Finisher of your faith!
