Focus Point:

Matthew 28:19 -20 (ESV)

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

Personal Reflection: Am I actively involved in disciple making? Am I teaching others how to live a life as a follower of Jesus?

Personal Reflection: List some ways you can actively take part in making disciples. What resources do you need to support this?

The **bystander effect** occurs when the presence of others discourages an individual from intervening in an emergency situation.

Personal Reflection: Has there been a moment in your life when you knew you should have acted? However, because there were other people around who could respond, you did not? If so, explain.

Personal Reflection: Do you find yourself in your Christian journey not being active. Active teaching and telling others about Jesus Christ? If so, why do you think this is?

Matthew 28:16-17 (ESV)
